Barbara explained to us that her existing kitchen was too small and its layout too choppy and cluttered. Her wish was to enlarge the space, streamline the layout and incorporate a large preparation area to bake. We made a galley kitchen with two-toned powder blue and dark chocolate kitchen cabinets. To complement this, the countertops in quartz and the backsplash are in a creamy colour. We installed Herringbone pattern porcelain tile that is easy to clean and gives a hardwood floor look. We also renovated Barbara's ensuite bathroom (see pic above), second bathroom and her powder room. She requested that we remove the jaccuzi tub in her ensuite bathroom and remodel it from top to toe.

Ingredients

- 3 oranges/clemintines
- 1 large fennel bulb very thinly sliced crosswise
- 1/2 cup thinly sliced red onion
- 16 small fresh mint leaves, torn in half
- 3 tbls extra-virgin olive oil
- 6 olives
- Pine nuts or sesame seeds (Optional)

Preparation

- 1. Cut and peel oranges. (Remove seeds)
- 2.Toss oranges, fennel, onion, mint, and oil in large bowl.
- 3. Add salt and pepper to taste.
- 4. Transfer salad to a bowl and garnish with olives.
- 5. Serve immediately and enjoy.


Lily of the Valley
